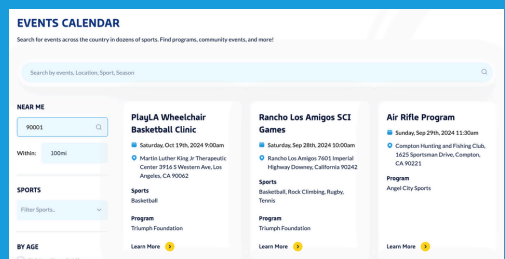

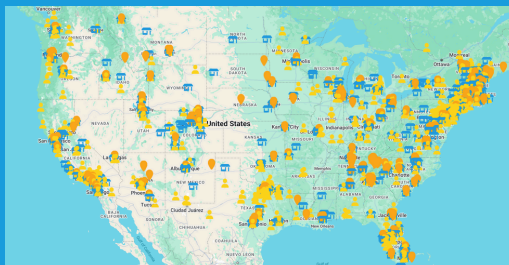

Scholarships



Up to \$500 in funding to people with SCI who want to:

- Try new sports and recreation experiences (camps/clinics)
- Gain more experience in a sport that you are a beginner at
- Have instruction or supervised experience to become independent using new equipment that you already own
- Test different types of equipment before purchasing or applying for a grant

Grants to help people with SCI purchase their own adaptive sports equipment.

- Anyone in the US with paralysis caused by an SCI can qualify
- Equipment must be adaptive and recreational in nature
- Experience with the requested equipment or similar equipment (including through a KBF scholarship) is required
- Average grant amount is \$3,500
